




This model can make two types of animal finger puppets – a cat and a pig. Fold them from a 6in (15cm) square of paper, and carefully draw the faces on your puppets. Make a group of puppets and invent your own characters for these lovable creatures.


The art of puppetry is a rich tradition of story-telling, popular with both young and old.




Fold and unfold diagonal.




Fold in half diagonally.




Fold side corners down to meet bottom corner.




Fold two flaps up.




Fold top flap up.




Fold top flap up. Turn over.




Fold corners in.




Fold up.




Fold all top layers down.

Completed cat face.




To make a pig face, fold ears over.
